GENERAL CREDIT TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. CREDIT TERMS: Payment terms are Net 30 (N30) unless otherwise approved in writing by the President, CFO, or Finance Manager of Makinex.

- Interest: A finance charge of 2% per month, calculated on a daily basis, can accrue on any past due balance from the date payment becomes due until paid in full.
- Accepted Payment Methods: ACH, wire transfer, credit card (processing fee will apply where applicable) or check.
- Completion of Payment: Payment will not be deemed complete until funds are received and cleared by Makinex USA.
- Non-Compliance: If terms are not met, Makinex may, at its discretion, require Prepaid terms without prior notice and/or suspend further shipments until the account is current.

2. LIMITATION OF LIABILITY: Makinex shall not be liable for any loss, damage, or expense incurred by the Customer arising out of the supply or failure to supply goods or services, whether based in contract, tort, negligence, or any other legal theory, to the fullest extent permitted by law. Where liability cannot legally be excluded, Makinex's total liability shall be limited, at Makinex's sole discretion, to: (a) the replacement of the goods or supply of equivalent goods or services; (b) the cost of replacement or resupply of the goods or services; or (c) any combination of the above, and shall not exceed the total price paid by the Customer for the specific goods and/or services in question.

3. GENERAL PROVISIONS: These terms and conditions are incorporated into every contract for the sale of goods or supply of services between the Customer and Makinex. They may only be modified or waived in writing and signed by an authorized representative of Makinex. The Customer warrants the truth and accuracy of all information provided in this application and acknowledges that Makinex will rely on this information when extending credit.

4. PURCHASE-MONEY SECURITY INTEREST (PMSI): Makinex retains a purchase-money security interest in all goods sold to the Customer and in all related proceeds to secure payment of the purchase price. This provision shall be governed by the UCC as adopted in Texas and any other applicable jurisdiction.

- The Customer may resell goods in the ordinary course of business; however, all proceeds from such sales (cash, checks, receivables, etc.) are automatically assigned to Makinex and must be immediately remitted to Makinex.
- Failure to remit proceeds shall constitute an Event of Default.
- The Customer authorizes Makinex to file UCC-1 financing statements covering all goods sold (including after-acquired inventory) and to take all actions necessary to perfect and maintain this security interest.
- Upon default, Makinex shall have all rights of a secured party under the UCC, including the right to repossess collateral without prior notice.

5. CREDIT REVIEW: Customer authorizes Makinex to make inquiries regarding the Customer's business and credit standing, including contacting trade references listed in this document. Makinex will conduct a formal credit review at least once every three (3) years. Based on the results of the review and the Customer's purchase history and payment performance, Makinex may, at its sole discretion, adjust, suspend, or reduce the Customer's credit limit without prior notice. As part of this review, Makinex may require the Customer to complete a new credit application to ensure all information on file is current and accurate. Failure to provide updated information upon request may result in a suspension of credit privileges.

6. APPLICATION OF TERMS: By signing this application, the Customer agrees that these terms and conditions apply to all goods and/or services supplied by Makinex on or after the date of execution.

7. WARRANTIES AND REPRESENTATIONS: Customer warrants that: (a) This application is complete and accurate, (b) All information provided to Makinex in connection with the application is true and correct, and (c) This application constitutes a request for credit by the Customer.

8. CREDIT INFORMATION & CONSENT: The Customer consents to and authorizes Makinex to: (a) request a credit report from a credit reporting agency for the purpose of assessing this application; (b) provide information about the Customer's credit arrangements to credit reporting agencies; and (c) disclose credit reports or related information to any related corporate entities or associated businesses as necessary for credit assessment and risk management. This includes information relating to creditworthiness, credit standing, credit history, and credit capacity, as permitted under applicable law.

9. PRIVACY POLICY: Makinex is committed to compliance with the National Privacy Principles and applicable privacy laws. A copy of our Privacy Policy is provided with this application and available upon request.

10. WAIVER: Failure by Makinex to enforce any right or condition under these terms shall not constitute a waiver of that right or condition, nor of any future rights or conditions.

11. GOVERNING LAW & DISPUTE RESOLUTION: This agreement and any dispute arising out of or relating to the supply of goods or services by Makinex shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Texas, without regard to conflict of law principles. The parties agree that any claim, dispute, or controversy shall be resolved exclusively by binding arbitration conducted in Tarrant County, Texas, in accordance with the rules of the American Arbitration Association (AAA) then in effect. The parties further agree that (a) The arbitration shall be final and binding, and judgment on the award rendered by the arbitrator may be entered in any court having jurisdiction, (b) Each party shall bear its own attorneys' fees and costs, unless otherwise awarded by the arbitrator, (c) The parties waive any right to a trial by jury or to participate in a class action related to any dispute.
